## WELCOME to our 2023-24 Ladies Golf Season!

We are pleased that you have joined the Viewpoint Ladies 18 Hole Golf League. Our League welcomes member with all levels of golf experience and abilities. We hope that you embrace the concept and values of the "Spirit of the Game "and enjoy your time on the course. The Ladies 18 Hole League provides an opportunity for Viewpoint ladies to golf together and enjoy the friendship of others who also enjoy this activity. Our committees organize socials, games tournaments and instructional clinics for our members throughout the season. We celebrate everyone's accomplishments in March at our annual banquet. Thank you for joining us for fun and friendship on and off the course.

**New Members:** new members of the league will be assigned a "buddy" who can help introduce you to the league, other members and the course.

Dues: \$35.00 (cash only) registration for the league is accepted at the Pro Shop. Envelopes for the registrations are available at the Pro Shop. Please provide all the information requested on the envelope.

**League Play:** Our season opens Tuesday October 31,2023 and will run until approximately Tuesday April 9, 2024, depending upon the number of ladies still available to play.

**Start Time:** Ordinarily the tee times are assigned beginning at 8:00am, with 8:00 shotgun starts beginning in January or as determined by the Pro Shop. If the number of participants and interest warrant it, the additional option of a 1:00pm shotgun may be offered. Additional details regarding start times will be provided to League members as the season progresses.

Our Webpage: Weekly signups, pairing, tee times, games of the day, entering scores for handicap maintenance, results and league news are posted on the webpage <a href="www.viewpointgolfresort.com">www.viewpointgolfresort.com</a> Leagues-Ladies 18 Hole.

**Pairings:** Assigned tee times and pairings will be posted on our webpage each Saturday before Tuesday's golf. Scroll down on our webpage and look for "pairings"

Game of the Day: Each week we play a game to add interest to our golf day. Some are individual games and others are team games. These games selected by our committee add to the fun and interaction on the course. The game and instruction are listed on our webpage for you to review in advance of play and are also attached each week to the scorecard which will be provided to you. We also offer an optional \$2.00 each per week Deuce Pot, Gross skins, Net skins. Envelopes for these optional side games are available each week at our Ladies drop box located on the wall as you enter Fat Willys from the Pro Shop. Enter your name, site # & date and place your money in the envelope clearly indicating which games you are playing NOTE: if any information is missed then your envelope will be returned to you unopened.

Check In: Please pay your green fees and weekly prize money of \$2.00 for the Game of the Day at the Pro Shop at least 15 minutes prior to your tee time. If after your pairing/tee time has been assigned you are unable to golf, please notify the Pro Shop as soon as possible but at least one hour prior to your tee time.

Hole in One: Your dues include a \$2.00 allotment to the Hole in One fund. This fund is awarded at the end of the season to those who have achieved a hole in one on a league play day.

Binders: We encourage you to record all birdies and chip ins and eagles that you achieve from each Tuesday league play day in the "Ladies 18 Hole-Birdies, Chip Ins & Eagles "binder which is located in the Pro Shop. Top achievements of birdies and chip ins and eagles will be recognized at the end of the season.

Notice Board & Facebook: The Notice Board in the Ladies restroom at Fat Willys has news from the League. There is also a Facebook group page (Viewpoint Ladies League-18 Hole) which provides League information and fun photos and items throughout the year. Upon paying your league dues you will be able to join the Facebook group.

Rules of Play: Play is conducted under the principles of the USGA Rules of Golf. Local rules are on the scorecard or you may ask at the Pro Shop, they are always happy to help. Please do not let the rules of golf detract from your fun on the course. We want everyone to enjoy playing golf in our League. If you are uncertain about a rule out on the course, play two balls to complete that hole then check with the Pro Shop for the correct ruling. The League would like everyone to play to the hole (IE: no "gimmies") due to the Game of the Day.

Establishing a Viewpoint handicap: to establish a Viewpoint handicap a player must have a valid Handicap card and/or record of scores from their home course or alternatively she must present five (5) scorecards, signed and attested from games played on the Viewpoint Golf Course or any other local 18 Hole course. The Pro Shop will assist you with getting your handicap established for league play. Handicaps for our league are based on ALL games played on Viewpoint 18-hole course or outside course play. You are encouraged to enter your scores for non-league play on our league webpage, if you need assistance on how to do this, please ask anyone of the Executive or other players. By keeping your handicap updated it maintains a fairness for all players especially when competing in tournaments, match play, Solheim and Club Championships as well as the game of the day and optional deuce pot skins games.

Other Special Events: Other League events and activities include for the 2023-24 season are a Welcome Back Member Tournament, Matchplay, Solheim Cup, Club Championships. More information regarding these events and activities will be provided to our League members as the 2023-24
