

Ladies 9-Hole League Championship Information
2025 / 2026 League Season

Note: League play continues for members that choose not to play in Championship Tournament

All Players need to sign-up online to play Feb 3rd, 10th & 17th & Feb 24th

Signup Deadline 12:00PM Friday before League Day

Championship Dates: Feb 3rd, 10th & 17th

(alternate date Feb 24th will be used in the case of inclement weather)

Scores from two of the three league championship golf days will be used for championship scores – alternate date (Feb 24th) will only be used if Feb 3rd, 10th or 17th is canceled due to inclement weather.

Alternate date will be used if weather prevents play for any of the 3 playoff dates

If a member is only able to play 2 of the 3 playoff days, those 2 rounds will be used for championship scores

Members will be notified by email if weather conditions are either unsafe or undesirable for play & ProShop will be notified.

Fees: \$ 5.00 registration fee

Championship Requirements:

2. Be a member of the 9-Hole league
3. Pay the tournament entry fee (\$5.00)
4. Have an established handicap
5. Sign up on-line and play in at least two of the three league championship days

Championship Rules:

6. Players must play out each hole tee to cup. All strokes count.
DO NOT STOP AT 10.
7. Handicaps are “frozen” the Saturday prior to the first round of tournament play.
8. Members will be placed into one of the 3 Flights (A, B & C) determined by the ProShop according to members’ Handicap Index.

Championship Winners

1. An Overall Champion will be awarded for "Low Gross" and "Low Net"
2. In addition to an Overall Champion, two Champions will be awarded for each Flight — "Low Gross" and "Low Net".
 - 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place will be awarded in each Flight (A, B & C)
3. Each Flight (A, B & C) will be awarded 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place for "Low Gross" and "Low Net"
9. In case of a tie in either the low gross champion or the low net champion, there will be a playoff of the entire nine holes during the next league play. If there remains a tie, the scorecard method will be used. Comparison of the scores of the 9th hole, then the 8th hole, 7th hole...until a winner is determined
10. If there is a tie in a flight, the best round of score for each player will be compared. If there is still a tie, the scorecard method (as above), will be used comparing the best round score of each person.
11. Participant's will be scheduled Tee-Time with similar handicaps
12. The ProShop along with representation from the League Executive Team will decide the Champions and flight winners.
