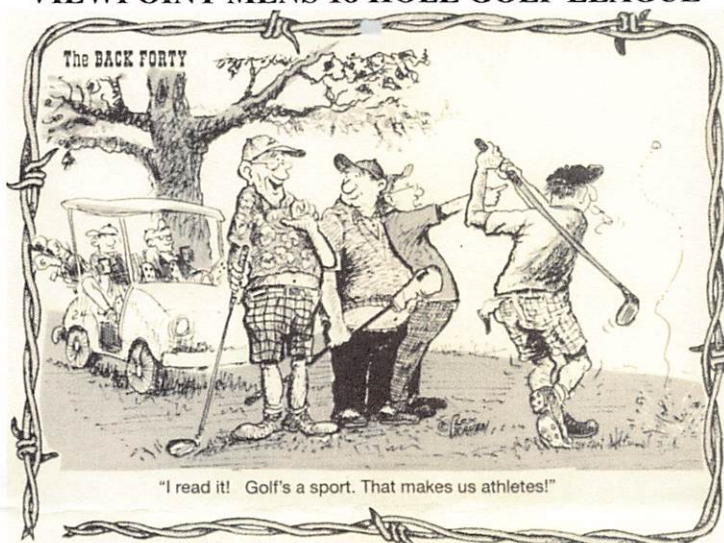

3. Choose tees you want to play from (blue or white). you will play from those tees for 2026-2027 season. We will use a Rule of 85 Age plus Handicap
4. Sign up to play golf on line , <https://www.viewpointgolfresort.com/> click leagues, choose league, sign up link bottom of page. If you need to verify sign up, click signup link, click live list. If you need to cancel play call pro shop
5. Click on league webpage for league info-pairings, league news, game results and etc.
6. USGA rules apply except as amended by league and local rules
7. Check webpage often for updates and news.
8. Balls may be removed from FAIRWAY divots and moved within a 12 inch ½ circle no closer to Hole
9. You may Pick , Clean and Place anywhere on the course when Cart Path Only is in effect
